(hereinafter the "Art Work").		

WHEREAS **Artist** is willing to sell the **Agreement** to **Collector** and **Collector** is willing to purchase the **Agreement** from **Artist**, subject to mutual obligations, covenants, and conditions herein; and

WHEREAS **Gallery**'s presentations catches up on the potentially trivial and known in the rendering of our iconographic culture, where the favored ideas regarding contextually seam to have occupied the "communicating place" in both image and action; and

WHEREAS an understanding of this situation leads us to refocus on the individuality and specificity of the exhibit, but without the yet privileged set of terminology inherent in today's contextualism, that again and again denigrates ideas of future too fluidity and temporality; and

WHEREAS the object is hiding an inscrutable inner life, initiating a debate on the reversal of power relations; and

WHEREAS maintaining this idea forms the field that shows a wide range of possible responses to a set of artistic dilemmas and takes the subject of artistic temperament and history beyond the general pragmatism of today,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereto agree as follows:

Art 1

WORK DESCRIPTION

1.0

to be filled in by the **Artist**:

Make an artwork that I really, really want.
The artwork has to include an element of crime.
All materials, actions and processes are allowed.

The **Artist** hereby agrees that the **Work Description** described above in *Art 1.0* can be produced by the **Producer** according to *Art 2*. The **Producer** should perform his duties, loyally and honestly to attend to the intentions described by the **Artist** in *Art 1.0*.

Art 2

EXECUTION

The **Producer** holds the right to execute a variation (hereinafter "**Variation**") based on their understanding of the intention of the **Work Description** described by the **Artist** in *Art 1.0*. The **Collector** hereby reserves all rights whatsoever to execute a variation, or to have a third part (hereinafter "**New Producer**") to execute a variation (hereinafter "**New Variation**") based on the **Work Description** under the following conditions:

(a)

The **Variation** or **New Variation** is destroyed prior to the execution.

(b)

The **New Producer** should perform his duties, loyally and honestly to attend to the intentions described in the **Work Description**.

(c)

There should only be one **Variation**, or **New Variation** at any given time.

(d)

The process of making a **New Variation** should be documented as described under Art 3 "**PHOTO DOCUMENTATION**".

(e)

The **Collector** shall himself pay all costs associated with the production of a **New Variation**.

(f)

The **New Variation** should be considered a meditation by the **Collector**.

(g)

The **New Producer** of a **New Variation** should sign in under the regulations described above.

Art 3

PHOTO DOCUMENTATION

The **Collector** has agreed to produce photographic documentation of all **New Variations** and of the destroyed **Variation** and **New Variations**.

3.1

The quality of the photographic documentation should at all times reflect the highest quality technology available at that time.

3.2

The **Collector** has agreed that a copy of the photographic documentation of all **New Variations** and of the destroyed **Variation** and **New Variations** are sent to the **Artist** and the **Gallery**.

3.3

Artist and **Gallery** hereby reserve all rights to copy or reproduce the **Art Work** or parts of the **Art Work**. **Artist** shall not unreasonably refuse permission to reproduce the **Art Work** in catalogues and publications that are incidental to public exhibitions of the **Art Work**.

Art 4

RECIPIENT / SPECTATORSHIP

When more than one spectator, in a private or public setting of any sort, views the **Variation** or a **New Variation** or the **Agreement**, or parts of the **Agreement**, all viewers and participants must openly contemplate and share their conceptions and understandings concerning the **Art Work** itself and its epistemological role along with the political potency and rhetorical ability of language & aesthetics as such (hereinafter **Society**).

4.1

Collector covenant that:

(a)

The **Variation** or **New Variation** must always be easily accessed and made visible in the current spaces it is being kept. Exceptions to this can be made during actual travel time if the **Variation** or a **New Variation** and the **Agreement** are to be relocated or taken on a journey.

(b)

The **Variation** must never be kept at one specific location for more than seven months.

(c)

The **Variation** or **New Variation** and the **Agreement** must never be more than 20 meters apart.

(d)

The **Variation** must never be hidden or stored in small and closed rooms such as bags, cardboard boxes or likewise. Exceptions can be made during actual travel time if the **Variation** or a **New Variation** and the **Agreement** are to be relocated or taken on a journey.

(e)

The **Variation** or **New Variation** and the **Agreement** are essential parts of the **Art Work**, and can never be sold separately.

4.2

If Art 4, 4.1 is not followed, the Art Work ceases to exist.

Art 5

EXHIBITION

Artist and **Collector** mutually covenant that:

(a)

The Collector shall give the Artist and the Gallery prior written notice of the

Collector's intention to cause or permit the Variation, New Variation,
Agreement or parts of the Agreement to be exhibited to the public, advising the
Artist and the Gallery of all details of such proposed exhibition which shall have
been made known to the Collector by the exhibitor. Such notice shall be given to
the Artist and the Gallery for each such exhibition prior to any communication
to the exhibitor or the public of Collector's intention to cause or permit the
Variation, New Variation, Agreement or parts of the Agreement to be
exhibited to the public. Artist and the Gallery shall forthwith communicate to
Collector and the exhibitor any and all advice or requests that he may have
regarding the proposed exhibition of the Variation, New Variation, Agreement
or parts of the Agreement. Collector shall not cause or permit the Variation,
New Variation, Agreement or parts of the Agreement to be exhibited to the
public except upon compliance with the terms of this article.

- Collector shall not cause or permit any public exhibition of the Variation, New Variation, Agreement or parts of the Agreement except with the prior consent of the Artist to each such exhibition. The Artist can advise upon or veto the proposed exhibition of the Variation, New Variation, Agreement or parts of the Agreement.
- (c)
 If the **Artist** fails to respond in a timely manner to **Collector**'s timely notice this shall be deemed a waiver of **Artist**'s rights under this article, in respect to such an exhibition and shall operate as a consent to such an exhibition and to all details thereof of which the **Artist** shall have been given timely notice.

Artist can demand to Collector, upon written notice to borrow the Variation,
New Variation, Agreement or parts of the Agreement. Such notification from
Artist should be made not later than 130 days prior to the proposed shipping
date. Artist's possession of the Variation, New Variation, Agreement or parts
of the Agreement should not exceed 61 days solely for the purpose of exhibition
of Variation, New Variation, Agreement or parts of the Agreement to the
public at and by a public or non-profit institution. Artist's possession of the
Variation, New Variation, Agreement or parts of the Agreement should
happen without any expense whatsoever to Collector. Collector shall have the

right to satisfactory proof of sufficient insurance and pre-paid inbound/ outbound transportation or satisfactory proof of financial responsibility. **Artist** shall have the right to such possession of the **Variation**, **New Variation**, **Agreement** or parts of the **Agreement** for one period not to exceed 61 days every 4 years.

Art. 6

VALUE

The **Art Work** transcends all contemporary and historically known value measurements.

Art 7

FEE ON ART STATUTE - BKH

Gallery D.O.R. has a charge of 5% in addition to the price that will go to the Norwegian "Fee on Art Statute". "The Fund will preferentially be applied to support artists who mainly have or have had their activities in Norway, their surviving relatives and other purposes to the benefit of Norwegian visual Art".

Art 9

FUTURE TRANSFERS

The **Artist** and **Gallery** should have a written notice prior to any future transfer of the **Variation** or **New Variation** and the **Agreement** from **Collector**. The **Artist** holds the right to, with a valid reason, deny such a transfer. In the event of such transfer, the price of the work must be higher than the price indicated in *Art 8* PRICE. The **Artist** shall be given 20% of the profit of any future transfers.

Art 10

AMENDMENT IN WRITING

The **Artist** holds the right to modify the **Agreement** in any way he wants prior to the signing of this **Agreement**. After signing, the **Agreement** shall not be subject to amendment, modification, or termination.

Art 11

DISPUTES AND GOVERNING LAW

Any dispute which may arise between the parties in connection with the agreement shall be resolved before the ordinary courts of law in Norway, and such resolution shall be based on Norwegian law.
